In English, we will look at poetry and write some list poems to celebrate Bonfire Night including some metaphors in our writing. We will then be basing our writing on a winter theme to include a narrative of the BBC adaptation of 'My Christmas Star'. For this text, we will be building our sentences and focusing on different features including similes, onomatopoeias, complex sentences and fronted adverbials.

This half term we will be learning about 'Light and Dark'. We will be learning about different celebrations throughout our focus weeks. These will include Diwali, The Birthday of Guru Nanak and The Christmas Story. We will also be learning about Advent as we lead up to Christmas.

Maths

In maths we will be focusing heavily on addition and subtraction. We will be learning to add and subtract across tens, find ten more and ten less than a number and then moving on to adding and subtracting across two two-digit numbers. We will then be learning about geometry of shape. We will be looking at both 2d and 3d digit shapes and identifying their properties. We will also look at lines of symmetry within shapes.

PSHE

In PSHE we will have a few focus weeks looking at Firework and Road Safety, Remembrance Day, Children in Need and we will also be involved in Anti-Bullying Week. We will then be exploring what makes us unique, understanding our core emotions and finding ways to express our feelings with others.

Geography

In Geography this term we will be looking at our local weather and how these change over the year and in different locations of the UK. Then we will look at different weather around the world and compare it to the UK. A particular focus will be to look at countries in Polar regions as well as near the equator.

Science

In science we will be learning all about animal habitats and those that can be found in our local area. We also have an exciting visit planned, where we will be exploring different animal habitats in our local area. We are also going to focus on things are living, dead and never alive. This links in with what animal and humans need to survive. Finally, we are going to be learning about and illustrating our own food chains.

Computing

This half term, children will be introduced to the key parts of a computer and understand how these parts work and how to use them. They will learn how people control technology through a device and use their prior learning to create an invention which includes an input and an output.

Music

In music this half term, we will begin by looking at 'The Carnival of the Animals'. We will look at the timbre and tempo of this piece of music and select instruments to compose music to reflect an animal's character.

PE

In PE this half term we will be focusing on our fitness skills. We will be developing our running, co-ordination and balance skills whilst taking part in circuit activities.
