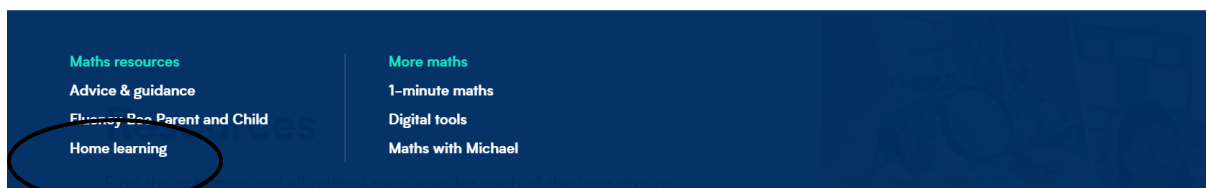

Hit the Button- great for number bonds and addition.

### Hit the Button

Quick fire questions on number bonds, doubling, halving, times tables, division facts and square numbers against the clock. Brilliant for improving mental maths and calculation skills, but particularly times tables either up to 10 or up to 12 times.

Mental Maths Train- great for addition and subtraction.

### Mental Maths Train

Mental Maths Train is a maths game which focuses on the essential vocabulary of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. A multiple choice game which can give children confidence in the four arithmetic operations.

Caterpillar Ordering – useful for place value and sequencing numbers.

### Caterpillar Ordering

A game for ordering and sequencing numbers. It has a wide range of levels including ordering the first five numbers, all the way up to 1000 and negative and decimals numbers. Sequencing levels include multiples and counting in steps up to 10.

Practising number formation is also an important part of maths learning in year 1. You can find lots of great songs on YouTube and there are plenty of rhymes that can be used to help your child remember how to form numbers.
