

Summer 2026 Curriculum Overview



English

In English we will be looking at increasing our knowledge of fronted adverbials and subordinate clauses. We will also be describing a forest made out of tin and metal to help children think about description in an abstract way. We shall also explore a fantasy story, 'Star in a Jar.'

Geography/History

We will be exploring both historical and geographical elements of our local area. In history, the focus will be on how the Black Country has changed over time with the differences in land use and the coming of the canals. In geography, we will be making field sketches of land usage today.

Maths

Children will continue to develop their confidence with fluency and reasoning. There will be considerable attention on the four operations and applying skills to two-step problems. We will look at reasoning and how to make sensible choices when deciding how to answer problem questions.

Year 3



Science

We will be looking at rocks, soils and fossils and considering the difference between naturally occurring materials and those that are manmade.

PE

PE will be a mix of core fitness training and cricket skills—looking at striking the ball and developing fielding techniques. We will also cover basketball.

Computing

For computing, we will be looking at inputs and outputs and delving inside a computer to see how it works. We will examine the function of individual components and how these components work together.

PSHE

We shall continue to look at what makes a strong community, focusing on the differences between rights and responsibilities. Finance and First Aid are also covered.

Summer Term will feature our ukulele concert with a date for this to be confirmed nearer the time. Children will also get the chance to play their music at the local care home.

RE

Our learning in RE will be focused on Sikhism. We will be learning about the origins of the religion and its role in life today. We shall discover Sikh beliefs, festivals and practices.

Music

Mr Pye will continue to instruct the children in ukulele. These lessons will continue on a Thursday afternoon so please make sure that children attend school with their instruments. There will be a concert in Summer 2.

Art/DT

In Art, we will be making abstract structures out of materials. In DT, we will be exploring and making pneumatic mechanisms.
