Year 6 Sleepover

As a reward for all their excellent efforts this year, we are delighted to announce that the school will be hosting a Year 6 sleepover on **Friday 3rd July**. Although attendance is not mandatory, we would love to celebrate the end of the year in style by coming together for a fun-filled evening and night.

On the evening itself, children should go home after school as normal and return to school at **6:30 p.m.** Children are welcome to bring their own snacks, but we kindly ask that they eat their tea before returning. If your child does bring snacks, please ensure that none contain nuts as per school policy regarding allergies.

Weather permitting, we plan to hold games and activities outside on the bank, so please ensure your child brings appropriate clothing. If the weather is unsuitable, activities will take place indoors in the school hall instead. The activities will be invasion games, such as capture the flag, cricket, rounders and football.

Regarding sleeping arrangements, the children will sleep in the school hall, which will be divided into two areas: one for girls and one for boys. As we will be using PE mats for sleeping, children will need to bring a sleeping bag, pillow, nightwear, and a toothbrush. Boys and girls will be assigned separate changing areas to change into sleepwear, supervised by appropriate staff.

For supervision throughout the night, members of Oakham staff will be staying awake at all times on a rota basis. The staff for the event will be Mr Skett, Miss Stretton, Mr Kettle, Mr Heywood, Mrs Barnett, Mrs Clarke, Mr Barnett, Miss Osbourne, Miss Owen, Mrs Boaler and Mrs Rivers.

For children who may require medication or support (sleepwalking, night terrors, etc) outside of school hours, please speak with the class teacher to discuss your child.

In the morning, children will be provided with a breakfast of fresh fruit, toast, and juice before being collected at **8:30 a.m.**

As a school staff team, we are thoroughly looking forward to hosting this event for such a wonderful group of children. We are confident that the children will represent the school positively and help make the evening enjoyable for everyone. However, as the safety and wellbeing of all pupils is our priority, please be aware that, in the unlikely event of inappropriate behaviour during the sleepover, we may need to contact you to collect your child. In addition, attendance at the event may be reconsidered if there are significant behaviour concerns in the lead-up to the sleepover.
